



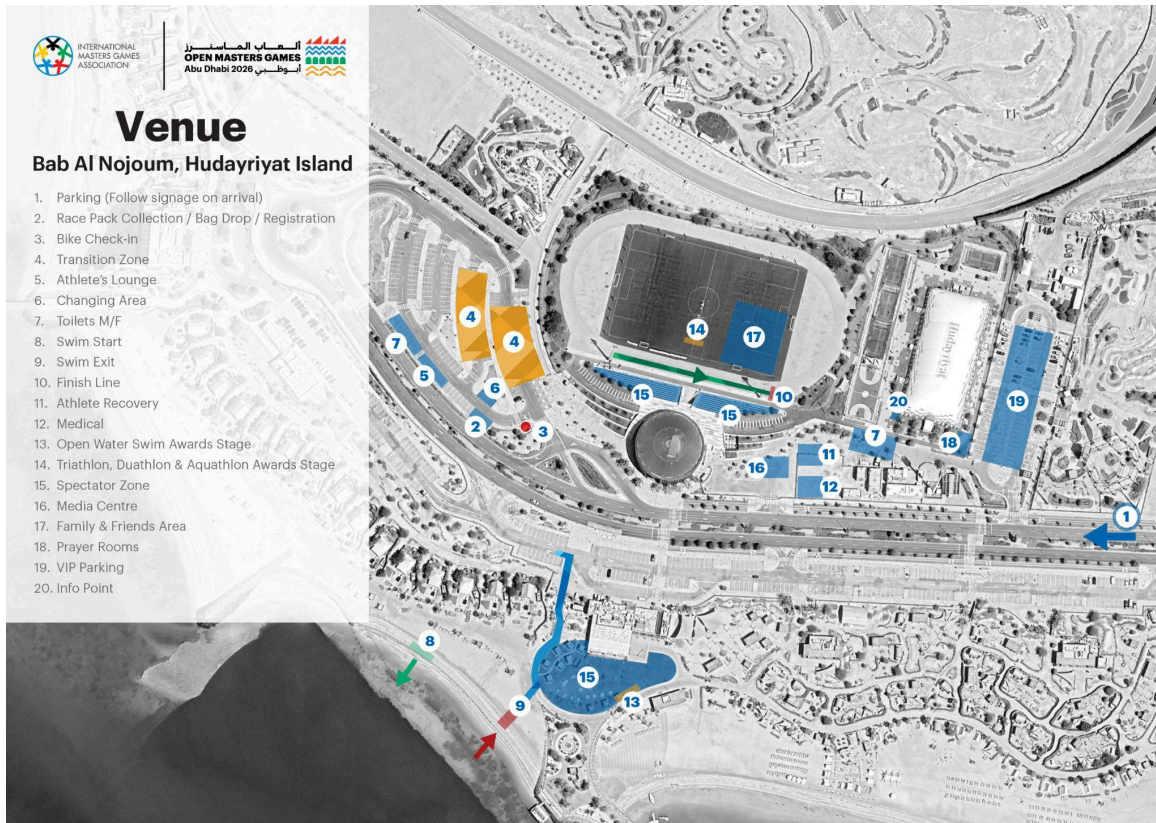
## OPEN WATER SWIM

### 1. Games Overview

The Open Masters Games Abu Dhabi 2026 is an international multi-sport event welcoming masters athletes from around the world. The endurance events will take place at **Al Hudayriat Island, Abu Dhabi**, across three days of competition.

## 4. Athlete Registration, Race Pack Collection & Bag Drop

Race pack collection takes place within the Race Village.

- Friday 6 Feb 9:00-18:00
- Saturday 7 Feb 8:00-6:00

Athletes need to present their Open Masters Games Accreditation in order to collect their race pack.

Race packs include:

- Body decal
- Swim Cap
- Race bag
- Wristband
- Timing chip



### Swim Course Familiarisation

- Friday 6 February: 10:00–11:30 (Last entry 11:10)
- Saturday 6 February: 12:00–13:30 (Last entry 13:10)

The swim familiarisation will be a 600m loop course. You need to wear your race wristband in order to gain access to the swim familiarisation course. Final entry into the water is strictly controlled for safety, and is 20mins before the end of the session time.

## Bag Drop

A secure bag drop facility is available within the Race Village.

Athletes must:

- Attach their race number sticker to their bag
- Wear their wristband when collecting bags

Valuables should not be left in the bag drop.

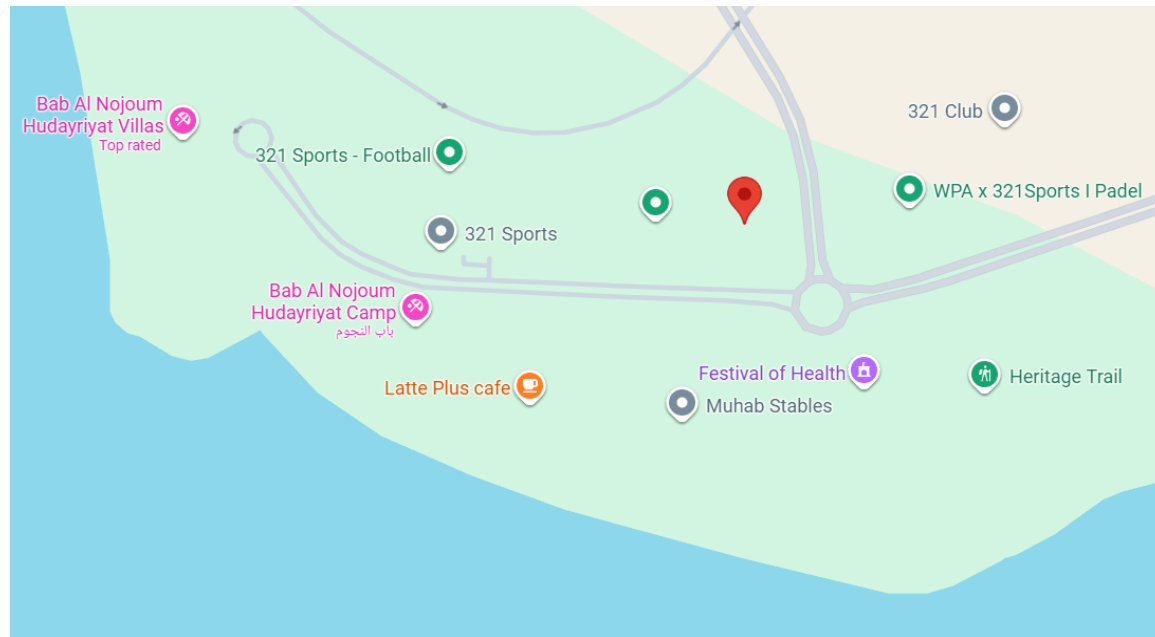

Athletes must:

- Check their allocated wave and start time in advance
- Wear the correct swim cap
- Wear their wristband to gain access to the start pen
- Start only in their assigned wave

## 7. Swim Courses





## Swim Course Description

- Open-water ocean swim
  - Clearly marked with buoys
  - Final course briefing will take place on the start line 15min before your scheduled start wave.
  - Lifeguards and rescue craft will be on course for your safety.
  - If you need assistance on course, please alert the nearest life saver by raising your left arm.
  - Course Configuration:
    - 5km Course - 4 Laps of 1.25km loop\*
    - 2.5km Course - 2 Laps of 1.25km loop\*
    - 1.5m Race - 1 single lap of 1.5km loop
- \*Loop size is adjusted to account for swim to / from the beach

## Swim Course Cut-off Times

The swim course cut-off time for all 3 distances are as follows:

- 5km – 2hr cut off
- 2.5km – 1hr after first athlete cut off
- 1.5km – 30min after the first athlete cut off

*Cut-off times are set in line with World Aquatics guidelines and are designed to ensure athlete safety and fair racing conditions.*



## 8. Results

Live results will be available online during the event. Final results will be published following verification.

Details of the results platform will be shared prior to race day.

## 9. Awards & Categories

### Award Ceremonies - Saturday 7 February

- 11:00-11:45: 5km Open Water Swim
- 14:30-15:45 2.5km & 1.5km Open Water Swim

Athletes are encouraged to attend their award ceremony in race kit.

## 10. Important Notes

- No jewellery can be worn and nails must be cut to a short length.
- For Open Water Swimming competitions with water temperature from 18°C and above, swimsuits (men and women) can be worn and shall not cover the neck, nor extend past the shoulder, nor extend below the ankle. Subject to the specific shape specifications, swimsuits for open water swimming competitions shall further comply with all other requirements applicable to swimsuits for swimming pool competition.
- For Open Water Swimming competitions in water with temperature below 18°C, the use of wetsuits is compulsory.
- Wetsuits are not permitted in Open Water Swimming competitions in water with temperature 18.0°C and above, except when conditions are hazardous for the competitors, the Chief Referee may, upon recommendation from the Safety Officer & Medical Officer declare wetsuits as mandatory in temperatures up to 20.0°C.
- Wetsuits shall completely cover the torso, back, and thighs. They shall not extend beyond the neck, wrists and ankles.
- The body parts, after the shoulder and/or below the thigh do not necessarily need to be covered

Athletes are responsible for checking the latest event updates prior to race day.

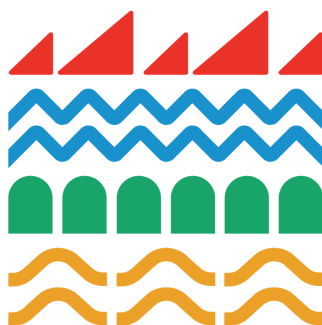
